

What You Need to Do


- 1. **Inventory Check:** Begin by unpacking all the boxes and verifying the contents against the parts list provided. Ensure that you have all the necessary components and hardware.

- Read the Instructions: Thoroughly read through the entire instruction manual before starting the assembly. Understanding the overall process and the sequence of steps will save you time and effort.











From Box GRG-BSP take the side panels and insert the hardware as shown and drill into place.








From the box GRG-BFS, insert camlocks in to the shelves and cleats, as shown below.



Step 4 With side panel flat insert fixed shelf and cleat into the panel.


Tighten camlocks on the inserted shelf and cleat with screwdriver. For base units all camlocks on both fixed shelves should be pointed toward the floor.




Step 6 Insert additional fixed shelf and cleat on opposite side. Tighten camlocks.




Insert side panel onto opposite side of installed fixed shelves and cleats.








You have finished the base unit shell.





Open leg hardware pack (HRD-552). Lay each unit down carefully and use the predrilled pilot holes on the bottom of each side panel to align your legs correctly and drill






From Box GRG-WSP take the wall side panels and insert the hardware as shown and drill into place.







Insert cleat and fixed shelf into side panel. Wall units have all camlocks facing away from the inside.







Insert remaining fixed shelf and cleat on the other side of the unit.






Attach the remaining wall side panel to the top and tighten camlocks to secure unit.














Take tall side panels form box GRG-TSP. Insert provided campost hardware and drill into spots circled below.


















Take remaining prepared tall side panel and carefully attach to the top of all fixed shelves and cleats.











It is recommended to install adjustable shelves **AFTER** installing all doors and drawers in each unit. The doors and drawers will act as a guide of where to install adjustable shelves to prevent any mistakes. Please continue only after verifying no further drawers or doors will be attached.







Insert provided wedgefix clips into adjustable shelves (wall adjustable shelves have only two slots on each side). Have all open slots of the wedgefix hardware face outward.




Insert and drill provided screw dowels into side panels. Ensure all three (two for wall unit) screw dowels are lined up evenly and correctly positioned where the shelf should go.






Step 4 Insert shelf with wedgefix clips facing downward into screw dowels.













Take door hinges from hardware pack and insert them into all open slots in each door. With a screwdriver turn the screws to lock them into place.






Use drill to punch supplied screws for handle attachment through the pilot holes on the door. Attach handle to screws on other side.







Insert and drill plates into one or both sides of the side panels to line up with installed door hinges.




Insert hinges into plates installed. The door should click into place upon attachment.





















Step 3Mount drawer back to attached rear brackets. Secure with screws.



Mount front fixing brackets to drawer front pre drilled holes. Insert drawer front.




If using supplied handle, open GRG-HRDP-DF position screws and drill to punch them through the pilot holes on the drawer front and attach handle from other side.





Install drawer slides to tall/base side panels using the diagram below to position your screw holes.



Insert drawer. Listen for a click to confirm it locked into slide. Repeat as necessary for all drawers.
